

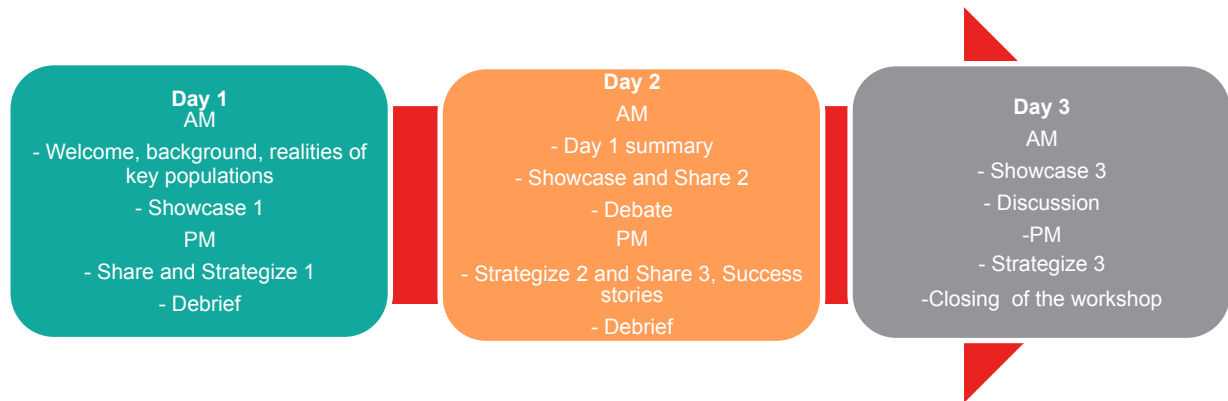


GLOBAL WORKSHOP ON DIFFERENTIATED SERVICE DELIVERY FOR KEY POPULATIONS:

Sharing success stories, showcasing hidden gems, strategizing next steps

FORMAT

The workshop agenda has been designed to maximise interaction and participation and focus on showcasing, sharing and strategizing. During the first and second showcase sessions, participants will be divided into three groups and the presenters will rotate from room to room giving their presentation three times. Fireside chats (one-on-one interviews) and a panel format will be used for the sharing part of the workshop. Strategizing will be done each afternoon in small working groups where participants will be divided into three groups – i) policy, ii) providers and iii) peers. There is also time on the agenda to listen and learn from key population representatives, hear about the vital role of peer providers, participate in a debate and engaged in moderated discussions.



Group work – name tags

There is group work as part of the agenda and participants have been divided into three groups – policy, providers and peers. The group you're in has been assigned and is denoted by the colour of your **lanyard**:

- Policy – black
- Providers - blue
- Peers - red
