What is differentiated care?

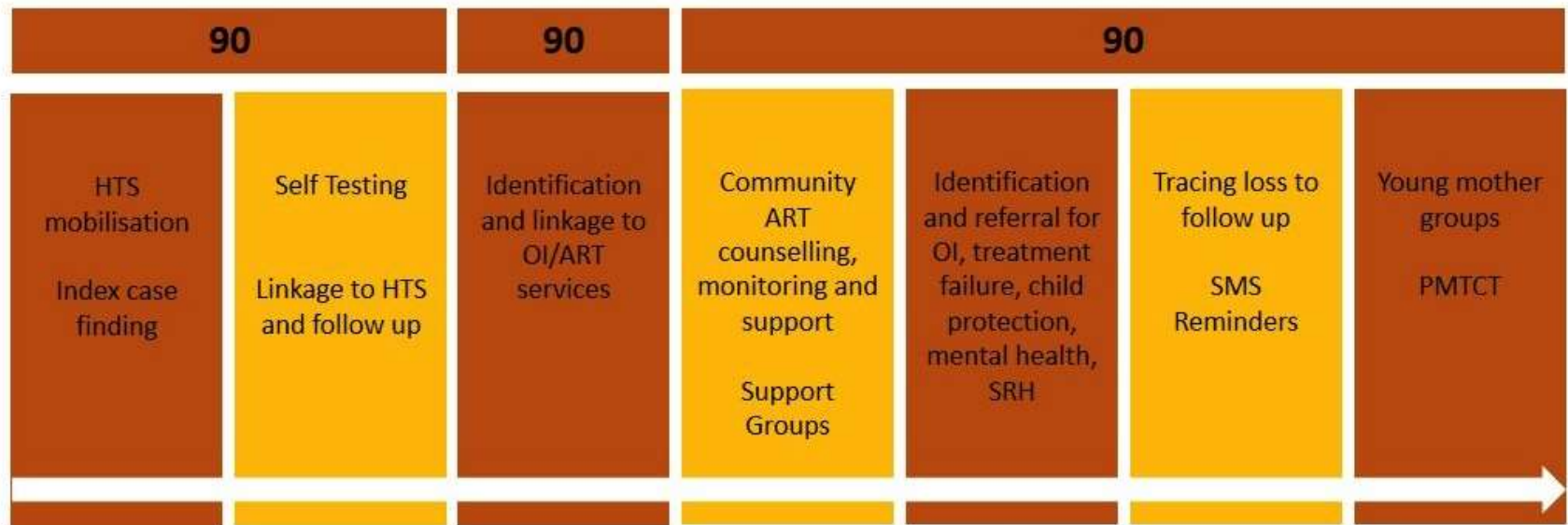
- It is a client- centred approach that simplifies and adapt HIV services across the treatment cascade in order to reflect the preferences and expectations of various groups of people living with HIV (PLHIV) while reducing the unnecessary burdens on the health facility.
- By providing Differentiated Care, the health system can refocus resources to clients most in need and drive to achieve the 90-90-90 targets.

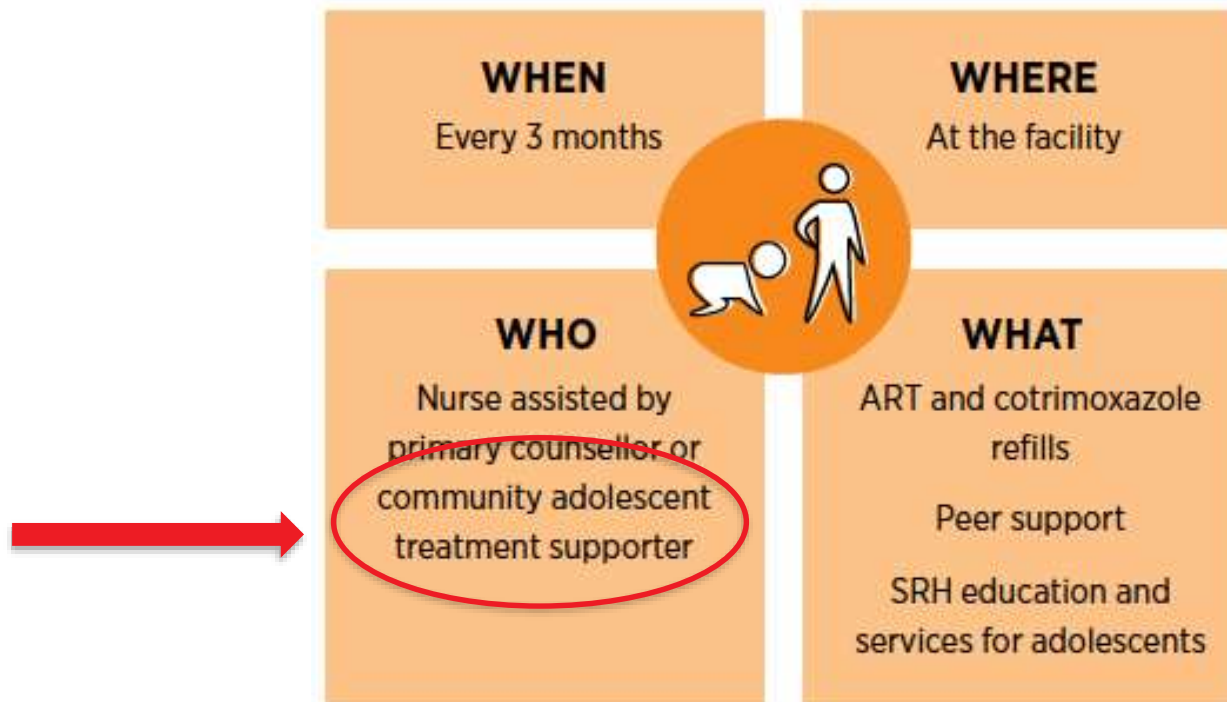
